Understand the current print environment

Effective MPS starts with aggregating data from four main sources.

First, we gather statistics about your print environment, such as the number and models of printers, fax machines and scanners, as well as output volumes and maintenance costs and financial data about leasing contracts.

Second, we comb your network for attached output devices using our data-gathering tool. In many cases, we will discover additional hardware not accounted for in standard inventory lists.
