Understand the current print environment

Effective MPS starts with aggregating data from four main sources:

Too few devices, and distribution centers risk not being able to complete logistics documents that keep shipments moving. Too many printers, and you incur excessive costs for equipment and maintenance. Simply imposing generic ratios risks disappointing results. Overall, we find that large manufacturers will typically have a fleet that is almost three times larger than industry best practice. And only about half of those devices are on the network. This creates enormous unnecessary expense and maintenance issues.

Improve document processes

Think about the work and types of documents that flow through your locations. For example, we can help you streamline and automate logistics document processes allowing for electronic routing of information, producing far fewer printed pages and making information instantly available to the people and systems that need it.
